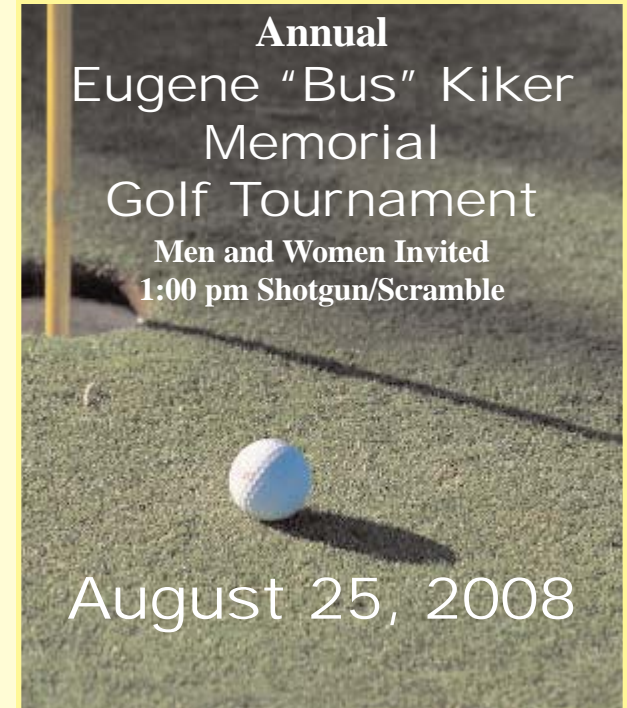

A Day of Golf Can Feed and Shelter a Mom and Two Children

For what it costs to play in this tournament, you could **provide a day of shelter, food and care for a homeless mom and her two children.** It costs the Atlantic City Rescue Mission about \$42 per person per day to provide this help.



Since 1964 the Atlantic City Rescue Mission has helped the homeless and working poor in a five county area of southern New Jersey. The Mission provides **647 meals per day, safe shelter for 250-300 people each night, primary health care, clinical case management and job training.** The Mission's goal is to guide homeless people to a productive life and stable housing through practical programs.



Last year, the Mission cared for **73 mothers and 143 children** in its Family Life Center shelter, **604 single women,** and **2,255 single men.**

The Atlantic City Rescue Mission is a full service non-profit, non-denominational Christian organization serving all of southern New Jersey.

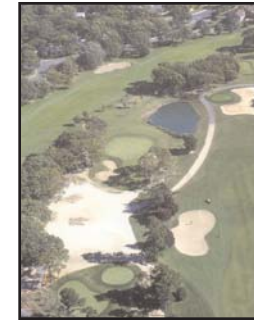
